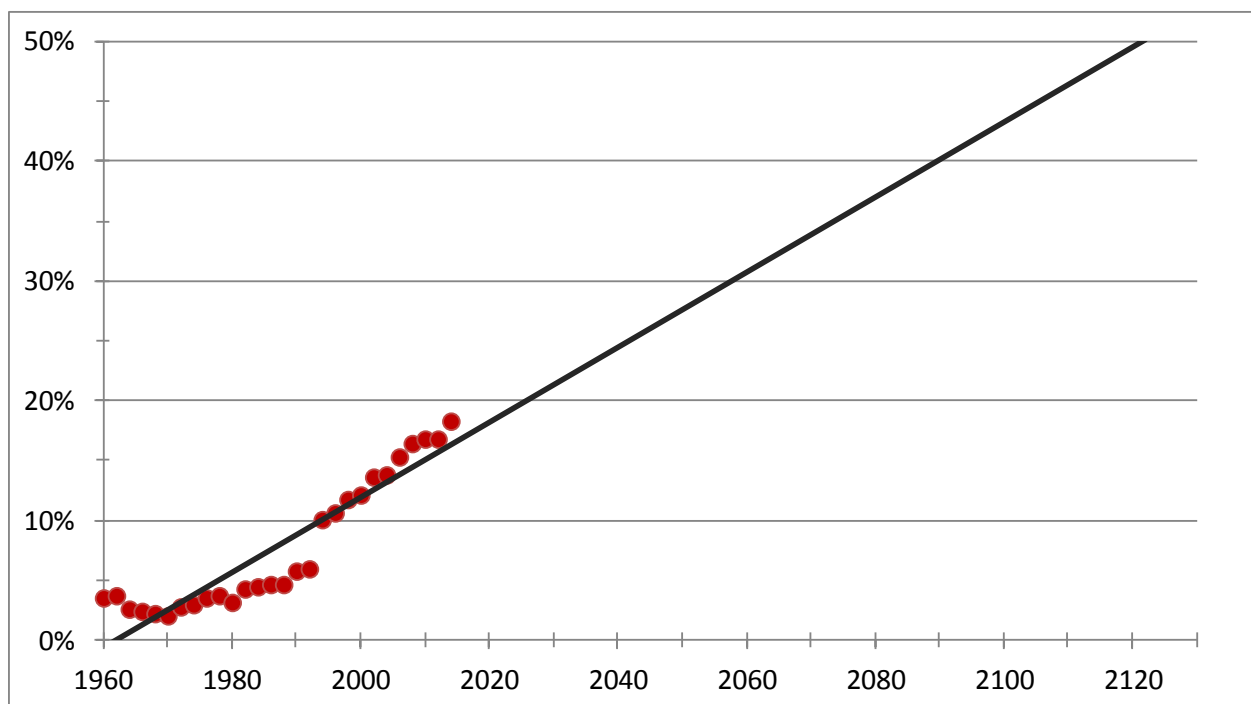


## Women's Share of Seats in Congress, 1960-2013 with Projection for Political Parity in 2121
